Three samples of art work must be submitted (include size, media and date completed), photocopies of art allowed, cover letter about art goals and personal interview required.
	Dunes Community Health Services Scholarship: \$500 to \$1,750 Open to seniors planning to pursue a degree in nursing medicine, physical therapy, medical technology, or other health career. Multiple awards given.
	Gardiner Odd Fellows Scholarship: (2) \$1,500 Open to a graduating RCCS senior who is planning to attend a two year or four year college.
	Hair 101 Beauty and Barber Scholarship: \$250 Open to seniors who will be attending a beauty or barber school upon high school graduation.
