Reedsport Rotary Foundation Scholarship Award Guidelines and Criteria

The judging committee will be made up of at least five members of the Reedsport Rotary Scholarship Foundation who will be looking for the following from the applicants:

- 1. Probability to succeed
- 2. GPA (grade point average)
- 3. SAT or ACT scores
- 4. Educational goals
- 5. Community Service outside of school opportunities
- 6. Work Ethic

Reedsport Charter School candidates are required to participate in an individual interview with the committee of judges starting at 8:00am on Friday, **May 1, 2020** at Umpqua Bank. Any remaining Reedsport candidates need to participate in an individual interview with the committee of judges starting at 10:00 a.m. on Thursday, **May 7, 2020** at Umpqua Bank.

All finalists are expected to speak to the Rotary Club at Bedrock's Restaurant on Thursday, **May 7, 2020** at Noon. The speeches should be two to three minutes in length and are an opportunity for the candidate to tell all the Rotary members about themselves, their family, school, community activities, educational goals and career objectives. Come prepared for your speech presentation.

- After the speeches at the Rotary Club the scholarship committee will select the scholarship recipient on the basis of the criteria listed above.
- Scholarships will be awarded on Senior Awards Night, May 14, 2020, at the Reedsport Community Charter School.
