

REEDSPORT SCHOOL DISTRICT

POLICY: SCHOOL DISTRICT LEGAL STATUS

CODE: AA

The Oregon Board of Education shall establish the "policy for the administration and operation of the public schools of the State of Oregon and carry out its duties as prescribed by law." The Oregon Board of Education shall consider the goals of modern education, their requirements of a sound, comprehensive curriculum best suited to the needs of the students and the public and any other factors consistent with the maintenance of a modern and efficient school system." (ORS 326.011)

For public school purposes, this state is divided into subdivisions known as school districts (ORS 330.005). This district is designated as Reedsport School District 105, Douglas County, State of Oregon. It was formed as an Administrative School District through a special election held November 10, 1967. On March 15, 1968, the clerk representing Douglas County Intermediate Education District Board, certified the election results of the election for the first Reedsport Administrative School District No. 105 school board held on March 7, 1968.

Reedsport School District 105 is organized as an Administrative School District formed primarily to provide education in all or part of grades K through 12 to pupils residing within the district (ORS 330.505 to 330.780).
