REEDSPORT SCHOOL DISTRICT

POLICY: DISTRICT BOARD GOAL SETTING

CODE: BAA

The Board, as the body responsible for establishing the direction of the district, shall employ annual goal setting. Through gathering input and planning the Board shall strive to set the appropriate direction for the district for the maximum benefit of all students and the community.

Beginning with each new fiscal year the Board will commence a process of generating concepts of projects that should be considered as a goal for the district. All members of the Board will actively seek input from the community to bring a wide array of ideas into the goal setting process. Public awareness of the goal setting will be employed to encourage community members to submit ideas to the district.

Following a period of time sufficient to generate numerous concepts for consideration, the Board will meet to discuss the merits of each idea and determine the future goals. Goals for guiding the action of the superintendent will be derived as a part of this process. The goal determination process will establish a number of goals to a scope that is reasonable and obtainable.

Following the goal determination process, the staff will assume responsibility for writing the concepts in a format that designates details, timelines, and responsible person(s). The formal District and superintendent goals will be presented at a Board meeting for review, possible modification, and approval.

Annually at the February Board meeting, the progress of the superintendent in achieving the designated goals will be assessed. This assessment shall be a portion of the evaluation process of the superintendent.

During the regular May Board meeting, the Board will publicly review the progress in achieving the goals established for the year. Progress of goal attainment will be reported in the District Annual Report.
