REEDSPORT SCHOOL DISTRICT

POLICY: NOTIFICATION OF BOARD MEETINGS

The time and place of meetings must be given to the public and to the news media by which the public is informed. The 24 hour notice, according to the Open Meeting Law, must be reasonably calculated to give actual notice to interested persons and actual notice to members of a governing body.

If only an executive session will be held, the notice will state the specific provision of law authorizing the executive session.

No special meeting will be held without at least 24 hours notice to the Board members and the general public except in the case of emergency.

In the case of emergency, a meeting may be held upon such notice as is appropriate under the circumstances, but minutes will explain the emergency situation.

Dates of regular meetings of the Board will be provided to district employees, interested members of the public, and the news media.
