REGULATION: 21ST CENTURY SCHOOL COUNCILS -
ADMINISTRATIVE RULES

CODE: IFCA-AR

Creation of School Councils. It is the responsibility of each school staff to create a 21st Century School Council within their school in accordance with state law, Board Policy IFCA and this Administrative Regulation.

Organization. Each 21st Century Schools Council shall:

- Establish length of terms on the council.
- Establish staggered terms which maintain continuity of service on the council.
- Select chairman and other officers as necessary.
- Establish time and location of meetings.
- Select a code of conduct of Adopt Roberts Rules of Order Newly Revised as a code of conduct.
- Maintain recorded agendas and minutes.
- Determine method of communication to Board, superintendent regarding ongoing council projects.

Consensus. It is the Board's belief that the consensus form of decision making is the desired method and should be used by school councils in the conduct of their business. Councils should deal with all matters responsibly and allow for constructive dissent.

School Council Activities. School Council activities shall focus on student achievement, staff development, professional growth, career opportunities and implementation of HB 2991 and the administration of grants.
