REEDSPORT SCHOOL DISTRICT

POLICY: DISTRICT PROVIDED INSTRUCTION

CODE: IFF

Grades 9-12

The District will provide for the expense of District approved high school instructional offerings that fall within a complete instructional day. The complete instructional day is defined as instructional opportunities that could provide seven units of high school credit within a regular school year. These instructional credit opportunities if approved may be earned through regular classroom instruction within the building, online class offerings, course offerings through a community college, proficiency learning opportunities, or other options developed and approved by the District administration. Expense of learning opportunities falling outside of the complete instructional day is the responsibility of students eighteen years of age or older, or the parent/guardian if a minor.

The District may offer credit retrieval options outside of the complete instructional day. The District may provide for a portion or all of the expense of the credit retrieval program.

Grades K-8

The District will provide for the expense of District approved instruction that is within the State funded criteria. A parent enrolling a student in a District instructional program that is not eligible for State funding is responsible for payment for the instructional program. The superintendent is responsible for the development of the administrative regulation to address the charge for programs.
