REEDSPORT SCHOOL DISTRICT

POLICY: STUDENT ACTIVITY FEES

CODE: IGDE

The district shall not require fees or other payments as a condition of admission into any class or subject which is part of the regular school program. However, the district may charge fees so that certain courses or projects can be designed to meet the specific needs of different kinds of students, and allow them to engage in special projects, some of which might be rather expensive and difficult to justify as a budgeted expenditure of public funds.

Schools may charge fees for the following:

- 1. Musical instruments that are owned or rented by the district. The fees are limited to the amount of the rental cost to the district or annual depreciation plus maintenance of the instrument;
- 2. Products that become the personal property of pupils;
- 3. Extra-curricular activities, security deposits, certain personal items, optional field trips, driver education, health insurance and reasonable amounts for such supplies as papers, pencils, notebooks and other items;
- 4. Security deposits for fines, breakage and textbooks may be charged and will be refunded if no fines, breakage, or textbook damage occurs.

The district will not waive fees for materials or supplies which are part of a program where a resultant product that is in excess of the minimum cost requirements and at the pupil's option becomes the personal property of the pupil, or for personal items such as student publications, class rings, annuals, and graduation announcements.
