POLICY: USE OF FILMS IN THE SCHOOL

CODE: IIABB

The district recognizes that films (e.g. movies, videos, DVDs, etc.) can be effective instructional tools. It is recognized that caution must be used when selecting a film for use with students.

Use of films with kindergarten through fifth grade students by school staff (during the day program or after school hours) must conform to the following guidelines:

- Rated as General (G); or
- Possession of a signed parent permission, with administrative approval for a Parental Guidance (PG) rated film; or
- Administrative approval of a non-rated film.

Use of films with sixth through eighth grade students by school staff (during the day program or after school hours) must conform to the following guidelines:

- Rated as General (G); or
- Rated as Parental Guidance (PG); or
- Possession of a signed parent permission, with administrative approval for a Parental Guidance for Age 13 and Under (PG-13) film; or
- Administrative approval of a non-rated film.

Use of films with ninth through twelfth grade students by school staff (during the day program or after school hours) must conform to the following guidelines:

- Rated as General (G); or
- Rated as Parental Guidance (PG); or
- Rated as Parental Guidance for Age 13 or Under (PG-13); or
- Possession of a signed parent permission, with administrative approval for a Restricted (R) film; or
- Administrative approval of a non-rated film.

Individuals or groups renting district facilities must complete the district Facility Use Form and meet the conditions required for administration approval for building use. Films rated General (G), Parental Guidance (PG), Parental Guidance for Age 13 and Under (PG-13) and Restricted (R) rated films may be shown if meeting all other conditions as required on the Facility Use Form.
