



POLICY: SPECIAL INTEREST MATERIALS

CODE: IIAD

In general, supplementary printed materials from non-school sources should have the approval of the administration before being used in the schools. This approval may be given to materials that are of obvious educational quality, supplement and enrich text and reference book materials for definite school courses and are timely.

Printed materials from non-school sources should not be displayed or distributed in the schools or on the school grounds without approval of the administration. Students may not be used as agents for distributing non-school materials to the homes without the administration's approval.

Teachers may use special aids such as models, films, videos, software, slides, pictures, charts and exhibits for educational purposes with the express approval of the administration even though these materials may bear the name of a commercial business firm that provided the aid.

Educational films and all video rentals secured from or through commercial sources will be approved by the principal prior to their use in the schools.

All copyright laws regulating the use of such material will be strictly followed.
