POLICY: GRADING SYSTEM

CODE: IKA

The District's grading system shall be based on Board-adopted course content and is designed to enable the student and parent to clearly know how well the student is achieving course requirements at the student's current grade level, and be based on the student's progress toward becoming proficient in a continuum of knowledge and skills.

Letter grades will be used in the District in grades 3 through 12.

Grading will be on a nine-week basis for grades 3-8 and a semester for grades 9-12. The grade will be based on many factors, such as: basic assignments, both oral and written; class participation; special assignments; research; activities of various types and kinds; and special contributions.

At the beginning of the grading period students and parents will be informed regarding the basis of the grades and the methods to be used in determining them.

Some classes at Reedsport Community Charter School may be graded on a "Pass/Fail" basis. Such classes will be identified and approved by the administration prior to the start of the class.
