POLICY: HONOR ROLLS CODE: IKD

To encourage general excellence in academic achievement and to recognize those students who have attained the specified grade point average, junior high and high school honor rolls shall be prepared and made public at the end of each reporting period.

Eligibility and Selection

- 1. Student performance shall be recognized within one of the following three criteria: 4:00, 3.5 3.99, or 3.0 3.49.
- 2. No distinction shall be made between subjects by assigning relative weights or by eliminating grades for any period or in any subject in which the student is currently enrolled. In instances where the student is enrolled in a particular course that requires his attendance for more than one period daily and for which he receives more than a single unit of credit (for example, vocational programs), the grade for that course shall be multiplied by the number of periods the course meets daily.
- 3. Selection at the end of the final grading period in each semester shall be based on the grades for the semester average rather than on that period.
- 4. Grades for subjects taken during each grading period are considered in selecting a student for the honor roll.
