## REEDSPORT SCHOOL DISTRICT

POLICY: COMMUNITY USE OF SCHOOL FACILITIES

CODE: KG

The Reedsport School Board supports the community education concept, which encourages the usage of school district facilities by community members for recreation, education and service activities. The following categories have been determined in order of priority for building and grounds usage:

- 1. Activities directly related to the required K-12 school program, including graduation;
- 2. Activities related to the extracurricular K-12 school program such as sports and seasonal programs;
- 3. Community school-sponsored programs such as classes and workshops;
- 4. Youth-related non-school activities;
- Adult-related non-school activities.

The Board expects the users to treat the facilities with respect. A <u>Facilities Use Agreement</u> form must be submitted by the person or group to the school office in coordination with administrators of the involved facility. The users must agree to all guidelines on the <u>Facilities Use Agreement</u> form. The original copy of the agreement will remain in the district office, with copies distributed to the appropriate building administrator, building custodial staff and facility user.

Approval for using the facilities will be granted for a period not to exceed one year. Requests must be resubmitted if the user desires to continue usage. The district may discontinue the facilities usage at anytime if it is determined to be appropriate.
