## REEDSPORT SCHOOL DISTRICT

POLICY: VISITORS TO THE SCHOOLS

CODE: KK

To help protect student and school property and to prevent disruptive activity, school officials must know if any persons who are not members of the staff or student body are inside the building or on the grounds.

Visitor are permitted on school premises so long as their presence is for constructive and not disruptive purposes and school officials are aware of their visit.

## Responsibilities

- 1. During normal business hours, visitors to the school building shall first come to the main office and arrange to conduct their business.
- 2. No individual may loiter in or near a school building or grounds. Loitering means not having any reason or relationship involving custody of or responsibility for student, or upon inquiry, not having a specific legitimate reason for being there.
- Students under disciplinary suspension or expulsion are classed as non-students and are subject to loitering policies.
- 4. Violation of the loitering provision may result in removal from the premises, disciplinary action, and/or prosecution to the full extent of the law.
- 5. Students will not be permitted to bring visitors to school without prior approval of the building administration.
- 6. If the district administration determines an individual has conducted himself or herself inappropriately on district property that person may be banned from all district property.
