## STATEMENT OF CHANGES IN ACTIVITIES and SOURCES OF FINANCING \*\*

Major changes in the 20-21 budget are a decrease in state revenues due to lower enrollment, particulary at the high school level; decrease in FTE of about 4.91 through attrition and program changes. The budget was based on the most recent SSF estimate from the Oregon Department of Education at the time of the budget meeting (February 25, 2020).
