## VI. PROPOSED BUDGET PRESENTATION AND DISCUSSION

- A. Josh Cook, South Coast ESD Assistant Business Manager presented a slide presentation to walk the Budget Committee through the 2024-2025 proposed budget.
- B. A budget is the district's financial road map for the upcoming fiscal year (July June). It includes estimated costs of goods and services and local, state and federal resources.
- C. The role of the Budget Committee is to review the proposed budget, provide opportunity for public input, approve the budget and refer it to the school board for adoption.
- D. The Budget Committee does not set employee or administrator salaries, benefits or contract terms. They do not set staffing levels nor decide whether or not a service or program should be provided. They also do not make district policies.
- E. The Budget Committee has the authority to change the proposed budget within the limitations specified previously. Once the proposed budget is sent to the School Board for approval, the School Board has the authority to change the approved budget.
  - 1. There are two limitations on the School Board's budget authority which states if the School Board intends to increase expenditures in a fund by more than 10%, then the budget must go through a supplemental budget process. Also, the School Board does not have the authority to increase taxes approved by the committee.
  - F. Committee reviewed the proposed budget and discussed questions and suggestions with the Business Managers and Superintendent.
