- 1. 7:40-7:55am our parking lot will be closed to cars. Once all the buses have delivered students we will open the bus lane to parents/guardians.
- 2. <u>School starts at 8:05am</u>; please help your child arrive to school on time. Regular attendance can build your child's confidence and sets them up for academic success.
- 3. The tardy bell rings at 8:10am; <u>all late students need to check in at the office before going to class</u>. Four unexcused tardies equals one unexcused absence.
- 4. Please call the office by 8:30am if your child is going to be absent. You will receive an automated call about your child's absence if you do not call our office before 9am.
- 5. The school day ends at 3:21pm. The bus lane will be closed to parents/guardians from 3:15pm to approximately 3:35pm. We will open the bus lane to parents/guardians AFTER the buses have departed. Please wait for your child outside. If you need to change your child's afterschool plans, you must inform the office BEFORE 2:30pm.
- 6. The security of our students is of the highest importance; therefore, All visitors must sign in at the office. Help keep our students safe by signing in, wearing a visitor's badge and making us aware of any unknown visitors. Background checks are required for all parents/guardians wanting to watch their students in swimming, help in the classroom/chaperone field trips. (Forms are in the office).
- 7. Breakfast and lunch is provided for FREE for all students. If your student has any dietary restrictions we need to have a doctor's note on file to make meal accommodations.
- 8. Please put your child's name and room number on all articles of clothing that might be left at school. (Backpacks, sweaters, coats, hats, gloves/mittens, swim suits & towels.)
- Electronic device will <u>not be allowed</u> in the possession of students during the school day. This
 includes cell phones, iPads, Kindles etc. unless there is a special function and the use is approved by
 the teacher/principal. (Ref: Student Handbook pg. 13)
- 10. Toys- stuffed animals, trading cards (i.e. Yugioh, Pokeman), laser lights, fidget spinners and permanent markers are not allowed at school. (Ref: Student Handbook pg. 19)
